## Curriculum Outline 2019/20 – Year 10 History (TWR)

### Autumn 2019

- The end of the Second World War and the start of the Cold War.
- Anti-communism within the United States, the Second Red -Scare and McCarthyism
- The African American Civil Rights Movement, 1945-74.
- The Women's Liberation Movement.
- Nixon and Watergate.

Students will study three of the four topics that will feature on the edexcel IGCSE history examination.

Part A will be a period study looking at civil rights in the United States between 1945-1974.

Part B will be a wider-world depth study looking at the Vietnam War, 1945 - 1975.

Part C will provide a study of British colonial rule in India and the nationalist challenge, 1919 -1947.

Links with fundamental values

Discussions on the rule of law in the context of the dictatorial regimes established in North and South Vietnam post 1954.

Discussion on individual liberty and national identity through a study of Viet Minh led calls for independence from foreign oppression, and within the nationalist challenge in India.

Respect for individual identity and liberty through understanding of the cultural and religious diversity within the United States.

- French withdrawal from Indochina
- Development of the Viet Cong under Ho Chi Minh
- US intervention and removal of Ngo Dien Diem
- US intervention under LBJ
- Viet Cong and use of Guerrilla tactics
- 1968 and the Tet Offensive
- Election of Nixon and US withdrawl
- Peace treaty of 1973 and eventual victory for the North
