## Curriculum Outline 2019/20 – Year 11 French (CLG) Set 1

### Autumn 2019

Principal Text: *GCSE AQA*

This year the students will prepare mainly the DELF B1 exam, but will also practise for the French GCSE.

GCSE Unit 8 and Edito Unit 7: Organising a holidays, and holidays in the future.

GCSE Unit 4: Talking about my free time.

Edito unit 11: New ways of spending our free time.

Edito unit 8: Let's save our planet!

Main grammar points: the subjunctive tense, the future tense, the imperfect vs perfect tense, the main relative pronouns and the gerund.

Students will be assessed after each point of grammar studied to check learning and comprehension.

At the end of each topic, an overall assessment will be done.

Students will need to work on the four skills (listening, reading, writing and speaking).
