Curriculum Outline 2019/20 – Year 11 Spanish (RLP)

Autumn 2019

During this term, Year 11 will work on the last topic, called "international and global dimension" that includes: being green, access to natural resources, sport events, music events, campaigns and good causes.

They will also revise the topics "Identity and culture" and "local area, holiday and travel", facing challenging text and listenings, speaking one-to-one and writings longer pieces of writing.

Students will be given "Revision booklets" linked to the topics to practice all the four areas.

During the term, they will have writing, listening, reading and speaking one-to-one exams that will cover these topics. At the end of the term, they will have a final exam that will include these three topics.

Spring 2020

During this term, Year 11 will revise the topics "school" and "future aspirations", practicing the four areas: writing, speaking, listening and reading.

Booklets will be given to the students to practice, and there will be tests of the two topics during the term.

At the end of the term there will be a final exam that will include these two topics.

Summer 2020

During Summer term, Year 11 will revise the five topics for the GCSE exam, being focus on the part they find more challenging.

They will have tests of the the different topics (Reading, speaking 1-to-1, listening and writing).

Links with fundamental values

Learning a new language and culture help the student to have a more open mind, to be more curious and increase their self confident.

They will be also able to talk with people from different countries and learning about their cultures.

Social, moral, spiritual and cultural content

During this year, Year 11 will be learning the first four topics of the GCSE, where we can be talking about the different cultural celebrations that take place in the Country, typical music etc.

Opportunities to independently extend learning Level B2 books would be helpful for Year 11 to increase their vocabulary and to practice.
